A. FY2021 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) Program Grant EXTENSION #2

D. FY 2023 Office of Highway Safety Planning Grant Agreement Approval

Moved by Dave Vandenbossche, supported by Lisa Beedon, to forward to the Regular Board meeting the recommendation to approve FY 2023 Office of Highway Safety Planning Grant agreement for the period of 10/01/2022 through 09/30/2023 in the amount of \$30,000. E. FY 2023 Crime Victims' Rights Program Grant Agreement Approval

Moved by Dave Vandenbossche, supported by Jorja Baldwin, to forward to the Regular Board meeting the recommendation to approve FY 2023 Crime Victims' Rights Program Grant Agreement for the period of 10/01/2022 through 09/30/2023 in the amount of \$170,489 with no local match required. The grant will provide funding for 2.75 full time Crime Victims Rights Advocates and 85% of a CVR Coordinator position. Carried - Voice Vote 7-0. F. 2021 Interlocal Agreement between Macomb County and St. Clair County for the Homeland Security Grant Program Approval

Moved by Duke Dunn, supported by Jorja Baldwin, to move as a Committee of the Whole (for final action) to approve the 2021 Interlocal Agreement between Macomb County and St. Clair County for the Homeland Security Grant Program in the amount of \$298,086. \$19,560 for SHSP (State Homeland Security Program) and \$278,526 for UASI (Urban Area Securities Initiative). Carried - Roll Call Vote 7-0. Ayes: Baldwin, Beedon, Bohm, Dunn, McConnell, Rushing, Vandenbossche.

Commissioner McConnell : John Osborn from the City of Yale inquired if assistance through the ARPA funds is possible regarding a generator they've had for many years which they received from Goodells County Park that is not functioning. Cost of repair far exceeds cost of a new one which would run from \$50,000 - \$55,000. Commissioner McConnell informed Mr. Osborn that a Committee will be formed for the ARPA funds but not until after the new year but would put on the radar for that Committee for consideration.
