King provided various updates on items in the HD Summary Report.

- Discussed Senate Bill 771 concerning the proposed Statewide Septic Code.
- EH staff recently performed 130 inspections at the Tattoo Convention Event in Port Huron.
- The source trace report for beaches was discussed. Primary site contamination came from canines followed by gulls.
- The Spicer contract for the Stormwater Program Permit will be going before the BOC for approval.
- Teen Health will conclude services on July 17th.
- The accreditation review cycle 9 will begin in November.
- WIC Management Evaluation resulted in an outstanding review. This was the best evaluation to date.
- Board members and staff should have received a survey for the Health Department's strategic plan process.
- Liz asked members if anyone was interested in joining the National Association of Boards of Health. There are also some free training models available via Region V training center.

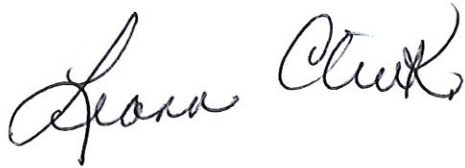
