A. Contract Approval Request - Westlaw/Thomson Reuters

B. Contract Approval Request - Corizon Health, Inc. d/b/a YesCare - Addendum #2 - Inmate Medical Services

Tracy DeCaussin, Jail Administrator discussed the extension of the agreement.

C. Contract Approval Request - Corizon Health, Inc. d/b/a YesCare - Addendum #3 - Inmate Mental Health Services

Tracy DeCaussin, Jail Administrator, discussed the current contract with Community Mental Health for these services and the expanded need at the Intervention Center. Some discussion occurred regarding funding for the increase to the agreement.

Moved by Jorja Baldwin, supported by Lisa Beedon, to forward to the Regular Board meeting the recommendation to approve amendment 3 to the agreement with Corizon Health/YesCare adding mental health services for a term of 09/01/22 through 08/31/23 in the amount of \$443,642. D. Contract Approval Request - Tyler Technologies - Jury Management Software
